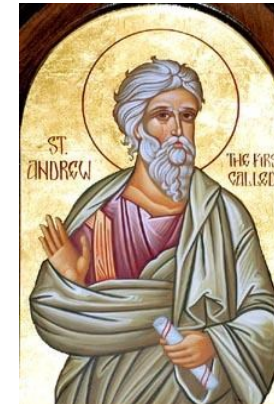

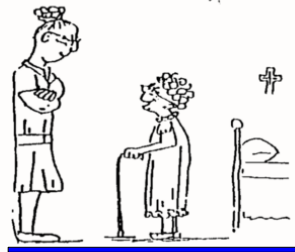
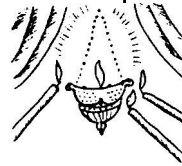

This will take place at the St. Gregory Parish located in Homestead, PA (214 East 15th Avenue). The day will begin with a Divine Liturgy at 9 AM followed by the plenary sessions.
